Make sure you ask your parent or guardian before starting.

- 1. Draw the smallest object you can find.
- 2. Draw the largest object you can see.
- 3. Create a painting or drawing outside.
- 4. Visit a museum or art gallery and sketch your favourite piece of art.
- 5. Create a portrait of a family member.
- 6. Draw your favourite possession.
- 7. Read a graphic novel and try to re-create your favourite scene in your own style.
- 8. Draw everything you eat in a day.
- 9. Choose your favourite art piece from your art class last year and create a new version of it.
- 10. Make a drawing all about your future dreams.
- 11. Create an illustration of your favourite book character.
- 12. Design a new superhero.
- 13. Draw a comic strip all about your summer holiday adventures.
- 14. Create a flip book.
- 15. Create a piece of artwork using only recycled materials.
- 16. Create an outline drawing of your name. Fill each letter with a different pattern or design.
- 17. Create a piece of art using 5 different materials.
- 18. Draw a squiggle and turn it into an artwork.
- 19. Read a book about an artist's life.
- 20. Use fruits and vegetables to create an edible artwork and photograph your creation.
- 21. Create a crayon rubbing of the textures you find outside.
- 22. Draw or paint the view from your window.
- 23. Find an image of a famous artwork and draw it in your style.
- 24. Read a graphic novel or picture book and
- 25. Create a collage which represents you using images from old newspapers and magazines.
- 26. Design and illustrate your ideal meal including starter, main and dessert.
- 27. Create a piece of environmental art using leaves, rocks, shells or twigs. Photograph your creation.
- 28. Create a continuous line drawing by not removing your pen or pencil from the page once you begin.
- 29. Create a piece of art which represents your favourite piece of music. Listen to the music and draw what you imagine.
- 30. Teach a family member or friend an art technique that you have learnt in your art lessons.
- 31. Play an online drawing game and print a copy of your creation.
